




Bridging the gap

Badminton England's Foundation Award and Coaching Certificate at Level 2 qualification **provides essential theoretical knowledge, including safeguarding, basic technical principles, and session planning.**


However, opportunities for **structured, supported practical coaching** within the qualification are limited

GALA Academy bridges this gap through a **practice-first, fully mentored, in-house training pathway**. Trainee coaches apply theory immediately in a live academic environment, gaining confidence, competence, and real-world coaching skills.

Learning pathway process




KEY

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Core Course Principles & Outcomes



Practice-First Coach Development

The course is built around the principle that *coaching competence is developed on court, not just in the classroom.*

Participants will:

- Deliver real sessions with real players
- Practice session delivery repeatedly under supervision
- Learn through doing, reflecting, and refining



Structured Practical Experience

Rather than requiring coaches to find a club after qualification, Gala Academy provides the environment.

This includes:

- Guaranteed court time
- Supported coaching opportunities
- Progressive responsibility within sessions
- Exposure to players of different ages and abilities



Mentored learning

Every participant is supported by experienced coaches.

Participants will:

- Observe sessions
- Provide immediate, actionable feedback
- Model best practice in real time
- Support reflective learning



Bridging Theory and Application

The course directly connects Badminton England Level 1 theory to practical delivery.

Participants will:

- Deliver real sessions with real players
- Practice session delivery repeatedly under supervision
- Learn through doing, reflecting, and refining



Confidence and Coach Identity

Many new coaches struggle not with knowledge, but with:

Participants will:

- Authority on court
- Communication with players and parents
- Managing time, space, and groups
- Coach presence
- Clear communication
- Decision-making under pressure
- Professional standards and behaviours



Progressive Responsibility Model

Coaches move through stages:

Participants will:

- Observe and assist delivery
- Support co-coaching sessions
- Lead sections of sessions
- Deliver full sessions independently



No Club-Hunting Required

A key differentiator of becoming a Coach at Gala means practical coaching experience is guaranteed as part of the course.

Participants do not need to:

- Approach clubs independently
- Rely on goodwill or availability
- Wait months to gain experience

Outcome: Coaches graduate with confidence to run sessions, not just plan them.

Outcome: No reliance on external clubs or informal arrangements.

Outcome: Coaches understand why something works and how to improve it.

Outcome: Theory becomes usable, not abstract.

Outcome: Coaches feel credible, confident, and prepared.

Outcome: Development is gradual, safe, and effective.

Outcome: Faster development and a clearer pathway into coaching roles.

Requirements & Pathway Fees



An **assessment** shall be carried out prior to acceptance to the learning pathway. The assessment shall last up to 4 weeks by attending different sessions. The **cost of this assessment** shall be **£35**. At the end of the assessment a placement will be offered and an outline duration set for the student.

Key requirements are that the **student's attendance shall be >90%** and the student will **enter into an agreement** before commencement.

The Pathway fees are structured to include both the core training costs and the Badminton England (BE) non-member course charges. All fees are paid monthly by Direct Debit.

Foundation Award – Level 1

Duration of course ~6 to 8 months

Total fees £895 payable

Comprising

£595 training fees

£230 BE course fees

Coach Certification – Level 2

Duration of course ~12 to 15 months

Total fees £1,660 payable

Comprising

£1,190 training fees

£470 BE course fees



Benefits to the New Coach

Tangible benefits

After successfully passing the Foundation Award or the Coach Certificate, the New Coach will be able to practice within the academy and get paid to recoup their training fees.

- ❖ Foundation award students **can earn up to £20 per hour**
- ❖ Level 2 student **can earn up to £35 per hour**
- ❖ Introduction of students to the academy incentive **£250 per student***

Non-Tangible benefits

- ❑ **Faster progression as a coach** through consistent, supervised on-court delivery in one environment
- ❑ **Real confidence**, built from leading sessions weekly with diverse age groups and abilities
- ❑ **Strong session control and leadership skills**, developed through repeated delivery in a familiar setting
- ❑ **Effective behaviour-management strategies** for challenging or disengaged players
- ❑ **Advanced communication and encouragement techniques** that improve player motivation and focus
